

«Principles and methods of EU project management and access to European funds with a special focus on the biotechnology issue»

The seminar will address a general framework of international cooperation projects and will introduce the basic concepts for all EU Programs. It will focus on the four common stages of EU project management: (i) definition of the Goal and Scope; (ii) managing contractual procedures with the European Commission or National and International Agencies; (iii) organizing and planning the project work and managing the project partnership; (iv) monitor the project development on a technical and financial point of view and evaluate its outcomes.
